

Mutual Ministry with South Acton Congregational Church

During 2024, the South Acton Congregational Church (SACC) approached West Concord Union Church (WCUC) about the possibility of becoming a ministry partner. Through a process of discernment, SACC decided to develop a covenantal partnership with WCUC and begin experimenting with shared worship. Meanwhile, SACC leadership planned for the dissolution of their organization.

It is the hope of both churches that our similar cultures and diverse gifts will combine for the good of all and that many SACC members will find a spiritual home at WCUC. As of January 2025, SACC members are worshipping with WCUC full-time and we are actively engaged in the work of building community together. At WCUC, we are learning SACC stories and history and seek to honor the collective and individual gifts of SACC members in our midst.
