

## HOUSEHOLD GOODS STARTER KITS

Household Goods has approximately 12 families arrive six afternoons a week, seeking free household items. That's 72 families (and many more individuals) each week needing the most essential items for their homes. Kitchen kits are much appreciated by our families, along with the *always needed* pots and pans. Without these items they are forced to eat out of a can, or from Fast food places. Sewing and tool kits allow them to repair their clothing, and make repairs to their homes, or hang pictures and drapes. These are fun to make with your kids.

### KITCHEN STARTER KITS

Kitchen linens: 2 towels, 1 dish cloth, 1 sponge, 2 pot holders	Kitchen tongs
Spatula/lifter	Utility (medium sized) knife
Cooking spoon	Paring knife
Slotted cooking spoon	Peeler
Potato masher	Pizza cutter
Wire whisk	Measuring cups
Rubber spatula	Measuring spoons
Can opener	Bag clips

(Package all items in *jumbo* zip lock bag, labeled "Kitchen Starter Kit - Wash before using)

### TOOL KIT

Hammer (not too large)	Small baggie or container of assorted screws and nails
Screw drivers: Phillips head and flat head	Picture hangers
Pliers - needle nose and regular	Measuring tape

(Package all in a large or *jumbo*-sized Ziploc bag, and label)

### SEWING KIT

Thread - several colors	Variety of buttons (sizes and colors)
Needles	Small scissors
Pins	Safety pins
Measuring tape	

(Place in small decorative tin or box with label, "Sewing Kit")

### TOWEL KIT

One bath towel	One wash cloth
One hand towel	

(Tie all up like a package with ribbon or twine)
